Agriculture as GDP Value Added (\$) & as Share of Total Employment (%)



Share of the labor force employed in agriculture, 2017




Share of persons of working age who were engaged in any activity to produce goods or provide services for pay or profit in the agriculture sector (agriculture, hunting, forestry and fishing).

% of people finding the following occupations prestigious










MARKETS I CHART OF THE DAY

TOP TEN INDUSTRIES EMPLOYING 16-19 YEAR OLDS, JULY 2016





- > Training and educating the next generation of farmers and consumers




